## DAY 1 MONDAY, JUNE 5

### WICHITA, KS

(Dinner)

We board our motorcoach this morning and head south with stops for comfort and lunch on our own along the way. The day's journey comes to an end in **Wichita**, **KS**, where we will check in to the **Hilton Garden Inn Wichita Downtown** (or similar) and enjoy a welcome dinner together.

#### DAY 2 TUESDAY, JUNE 6

#### OKLAHOMA CITY, OK

(Breakfast, Lunch)

After breakfast at the hotel, we will head to Pawhuska, OK, to visit **The Mercantile**. Owned by Ree Drummond, known across the country as the Pioneer Woman, The Mercantile is a general store, deli, and bakery all wrapped into one! After lunch and time to explore this homage to small-town America, we will depart for **Oklahoma City, OK**. Upon arrival at the **Hampton Inn & Suites Oklahoma City Bricktown** (or similar), the remainder of the evening is at your leisure. This former warehouse district is rich with history, full of beauty, and alive with constant activity. Dine at one of the area's many restaurants, enjoy a nightcap, and browse the unique selection of shops.

### DAY 3 WEDNESDAY, JUNE 7

#### DALLAS, TX

(Breakfast, Dinner)

Following breakfast we will continue our drive south to Dallas, TX, to visit the **George W. Bush Presidential Library & Museum**. The library examines the life and career of our nation's forty-third president and the principles he followed when making critical decisions. The fascinating exhibits include a full-size replica of the Oval Office and the original White House Situation Room, plus the poignant "Nation Under Attack" exhibit that displays the letters President Bush received in the days after the September 11th attacks, the bullhorn he used to address the crowd at Ground Zero, and steel from the World Trade Center. We will then continue on to **Southfork Ranch**, the place the Ewings called home for thirteen years on the TV series *Dallas*. Our group will learn about the history of the ranch, explore the Ewing Mansion and show memorabilia, and hear interesting stories from the set. After a dinner at the ranch fit for a cowboy, we'll head back into the city to settle in to the **DoubleTree Dallas Market Center** (or similar) for the remainder of the evening.

#### DAY 4 THURSDAY, JUNE 8

#### WACO, TX

(Breakfast, Dinner)

We will depart after breakfast for the remainder of our journey to Waco, TX. Upon arrival in Waco, we will meet our step-on guide and begin a driving tour of some homes and landmarks from the Fixer Upper world, including the suspension bridge and the ALICO building in downtown Waco, various shops, and new projects the Gaineses are working on. Along the way, stops will be made at the JDH Iron Designs retail trailer and Harp Design Co. to do some shopping. The afternoon is yours to **explore Waco your way!** A free trolley will be available for those looking to explore downtown. Downtown Waco is a unique cultural district brimming with fun finds, from antiques and home decor to artisanal crafts and high-end boutiques. The star of downtown is certainly the Magnolia Silos property owned by Chip and Joanna Gaines. There's so much to see and do here, starting with Magnolia Market. This home goods shop is where you can find a variety of decor pieces in Joanna's signature style, including baskets, signage, knick knacks, and furniture. Some of the newest additions to the Magnolia family are the Shops at the Silos, six shops dedicated to specific styles and themes. There is the book and paper collection at Chapter One, men's goods at No. 16, and bath and body products at Vie Bien Aimee. Then there's women's clothing at Reverie, bags and other accessories at Tried and True, and kids items at Juniper & Crew. As you revel in the Magnolia atmosphere, be sure to grab a drink at Magnolia Press, a sweet treat at Silos Baking Co., and lunch at one of the food trucks! Other unique places downtown include The Findery, Common Grounds, Heritage Creamery, Laverty's Antiques and Furnishings, and Spice Village. To explore a little history, consider the Dr. Pepper Museum or the Texas Ranger Hall of Fame and Museum. Our day will come to an end with dinner together at one of Waco's many fun restaurants followed by an evening to relax at the Holiday Inn Waco (or similar).

## DAY 5 FRIDAY, JUNE 9 FORT WORTH, TX (Breakfast)

Still need time to explore? Use the morning on your own to visit new shops or make a return visit to some of your favorites! We'll then say goodbye to Waco as we depart for **Fort Worth** and the **Courtyard Fort Worth Historic Stockyards** (or similar). The evening is yours to have dinner and explore the **Stockyards National Historic District**. Walk down the weathered brick streets and catch a glimpse of a time when most of western United States was unsettled and throngs of people were flooding to the area to start a new life. Be sure to catch Texas cowhands as they drive a herd of Texas longhorns down Exchange Avenue!

#### DAY 6 SATURDAY, JUNE 10

#### TOPEKA, KS

#### (Breakfast, Dinner)

Today will be an opportunity to relax and enjoy the scenery on our travels north. We'll drive as far as **Topeka**, **KS**, making stops for comfort and lunch on our own along the way. After checking in to the **Hampton Inn Topeka** (or similar), time will be available to freshen up before we gather for a delightful farewell dinner as a group.

#### DAY 7 SUNDAY, JUNE 11

After breakfast at the hotel, we will depart on the rest of our journey home with periodic stops along the way.


