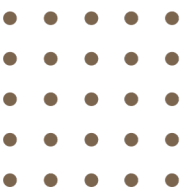

9-day expedition America's deepest river gorge. Includes guided excursions, gourmet dining, wildlife viewing, and stops at historic sites along the scenic Snake River.

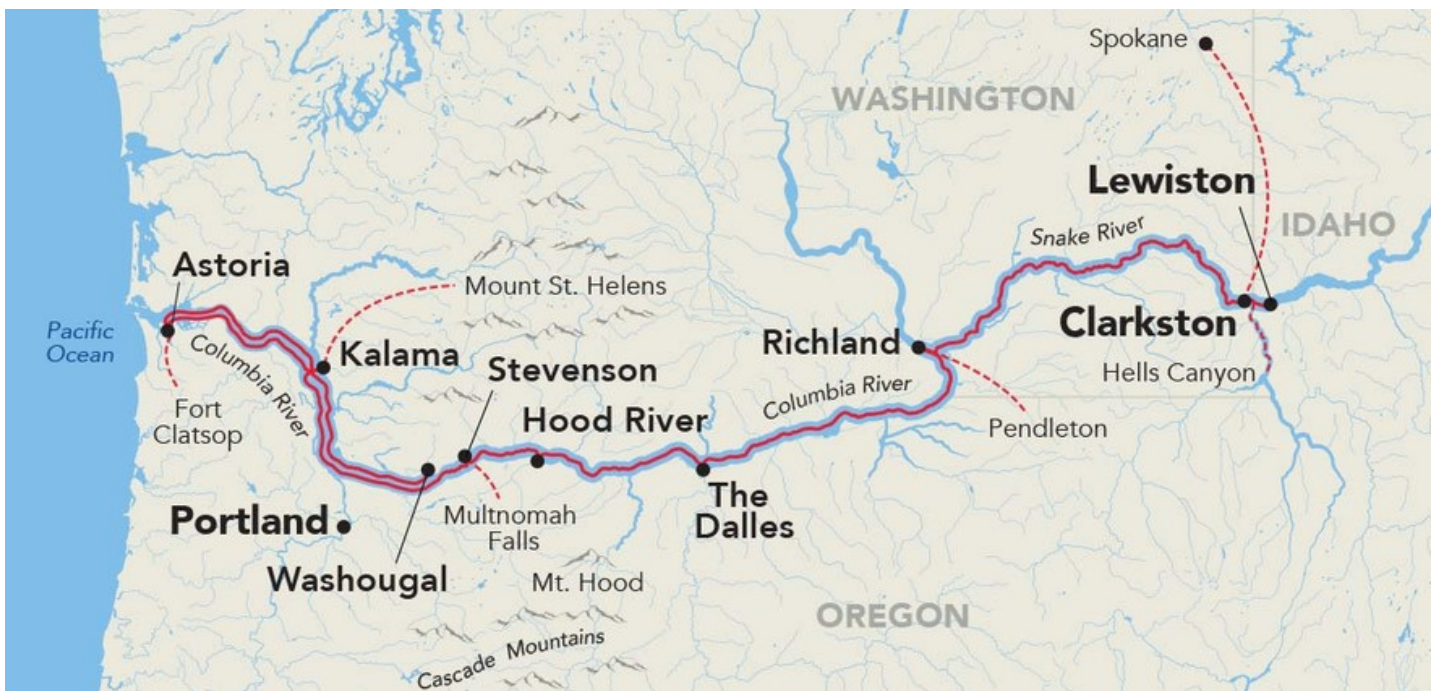
