HOME

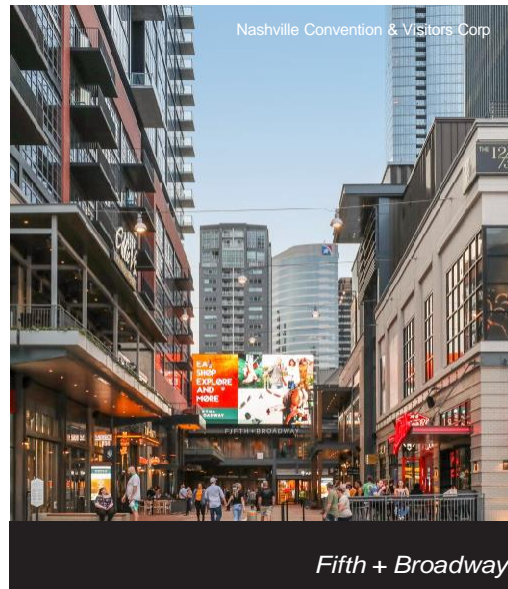
(Breakfast)
